# Why might you not get the choices you want?

- Class is under subscribed too few pupils to make the class viable
- Class is over subscribed too many pupils in that class. (Decision of PT)
- There may be a clash between 2 subjects that are only available in the same slot on the timetable.
- School staffing may not allow, or limit the scope for providing some subjects
- Pupils hand their form in late.

We require all pupils to make reserve choices. As in previous years if we cannot meet the requests for all subjects from a pupil we will use the reserve choice. Your child's Guidance Teacher will re—interview if it has not been possible to allocate a reserve or if more that one request cannot be met.
