- Have an overview of the class and its pupils. They will oversee pupils progress, academically, discipline and wider achievement. First point of contact for parents.

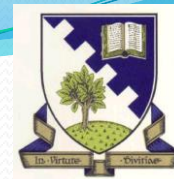
- S6 Buddies
