
In S1 **Music** you will have the opportunity to develop listening skills, compose and learn to play a variety of classroom instruments including:

Looking at how you change your voice depending on where you are, what you are doing and who you are speaking to.




Dramatic Tension

The Youth Theatre is open to pupils in all year groups. The Youth Theatre is designed to allow the pupils to work in an environment where they can feel comfortable, exploring and using their imagination to create and devise interesting pieces of Drama. We meet on a Monday after school and the club gives students more opportunities to take part in public performances. We have an input into the Christmas and Easter concerts each year and have, in the past, participated in Dundee Reps', Next Up! Festival.



Theatre Production Group is open to pupils in all year groups. Theatre Production group is a club for pupils who are interested in all aspects of technical theatre. Pupils meet on a Monday after school. Pupils are given the opportunity to operate lighting, operate sound equipment and stage manage small scale productions. This club allows the students a hands-on opportunity to create and produce authentic theatrical production such as stage and sfx make up, sound effects, gobos and costume designs.
